



MISSION OF THE MONTH-MADISON AREA FOOD PANTRY

The Asbury congregation has been a major supporter of the Madison Area Food Pantry Gardens (MAFPG) since 2000 when the first gardens were established by former Asbury member Ken Witte. MAFPG has grown to become a network of 9 gardens in the Madison area that supplies first-choice, fresh, nutritious, and culturally relevant produce to about 30 Dane County food pantries and food programs including WayForward Resources, Extended Hands Pantry, Badger Prairie Needs Network, St Vincent de Paul, Bayview Foundation, The Hmong Institute, and others. Through the collaboration of community partners and 2,000 volunteers in a typical season, MAFPG fills nutritional gaps by donating about 120,000 pounds of produce to the Dane County emergency food system – *over 2 million pounds since 2000!*

Gardening is a tangible source of relaxation and helps us care for God's creation while helping to create nutrition security in our community. It also helps us grow spiritually as we cultivate more personal relationships within the Asbury family while serving our community together.

Asbury youth, young adults, and many others have been serving at Forward Garden at the 15-acre Pope Farm Homestead in the Town of Middleton (7492 W. Old Sauk Rd) since 2020. In addition to gardening, volunteer opportunities include playing with kids, education and mentoring, washing, bunching, and bagging produce, deliveries, chicken care, tool care, picking up compost buckets from local businesses, helping with marketing, social media, and events, and more. Please consider joining Asbury to volunteer with MAFPG at Forward Garden on one or more Saturday mornings from 9:00-11:00 am (April 20, June 15, June 29, July 20, August 3, August 17, September 7. September 21. October


